Arlington delegate to retire, take state job

Del. Robert H. Brink, D-Arlington, will leave the House of Delegates effective June 30 and take a job with the Department for Aging and Rehabilitative Services.

His appointment was one of several released by the McAuliffe administration on Friday, including June W. Jennings as the state's inspector general.

Jennings stepped into the role on an interim basis after Inspector General Michael F.A. Morehart retired last month. Jennings had previously served as the deputy State Inspector General since July 2012.

Edgardo Cortes was appointed commissioner of the Department of Elections, a position outlined in 2013 legislation that changed the name of the agency that administers election law to the Department of Elections and left the three-member board as the State Board of Elections. Paula Otto was retained as executive director of the Virginia Lottery.

Among the more senior members in the chamber, Brink was elected in 1997 and represents north Arlington, Crystal City and parts of McLean. Brink ran unopposed in 2013 and won the seat with nearly 95 percent of the vote.

House Democratic leadership also said Friday that Del. Algie T. Howell Jr., D-Norfolk, has resigned from the House effective June 30.

Brink will collect an annual salary of \$110,000 in his new role.

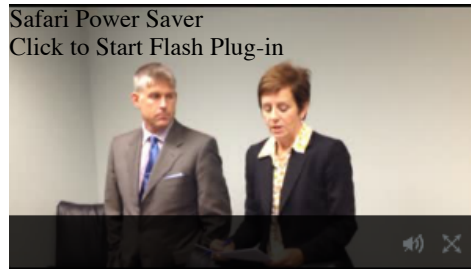
